EMERGENCY MEDICAL PLAN
SPRING 2010

An Athletic Trainer (AT) licensed by the State of Texas will be on duty at all Plano West home games, for both the varsity and junior varsity games. The AT will set up in a neutral area agreed to by the officials and both coaches. The AT will have on-site all supplies and equipment necessary for the sufficient delivery of basic field emergency care. The trainer will also be equipped with an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED).

In case of an injury to any player, coach or referee, the Site Administrator (SA) will summon the AT. The AT will decide if medical attention is required and deliver such care if necessary. If more extensive medical care is required the AT will indicate such to the SA and the SA will contact the local EMS/911 and request assistance at the field. A City of Plano Fire Department/EMS station is located on Alma Road directly adjacent to the Clark Stadium Complex where the Plano West Wolves play home games. Response time from this location should be less than five (5) minutes. The SA will direct the EMS to the injured party and AT and ensure that the necessary medical care is provided. The SA will also attempt to notify the injured players parents and/or legal guardian. If appropriate, the SA will contact the primary insurance carrier for the injured party.

Additionally, the PWLA will have access to a lightning meter at the Clark Stadium complex. The meter will be in good working condition.
